# O.G. TAC - GUAR TACKIFIER

Cross-linked guar gum tackifier - binds mulch to soil, knocks down erosion, holds moisture where the seed needs it. Pouches from 2 to 5 lb.



## IN PLAIN TERMS

O.G. Tac is the glue. Made from a natural seed gum, it turns your mulch-and-seed slurry sticky once it's wet, so wind and rain can't wash it off the slope. A little on flat ground, more on steep hills. Heads up: it's slippery when wet.
